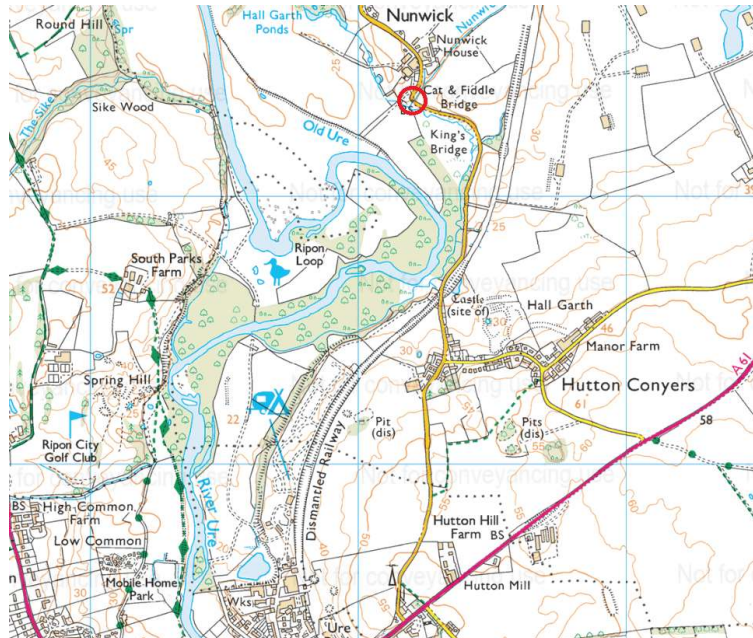

Directions to the Norton Conyers Estate Fishing

1st Access – Nunwick



From the A61 roundabout next to the River Ure on the North side of Ripon, continue up the hill towards the A1 for approximately 0.2 miles then turn Left at the top of the hill towards Hutton Conyers and Wath.

Follow the road through Hutton Conyers for approximately 1.3 miles. You will see a gate on the left of the road next to the Nunwick sign. Park on the grass in front of the apple trees, walk across the paddock and follow the track to the River.

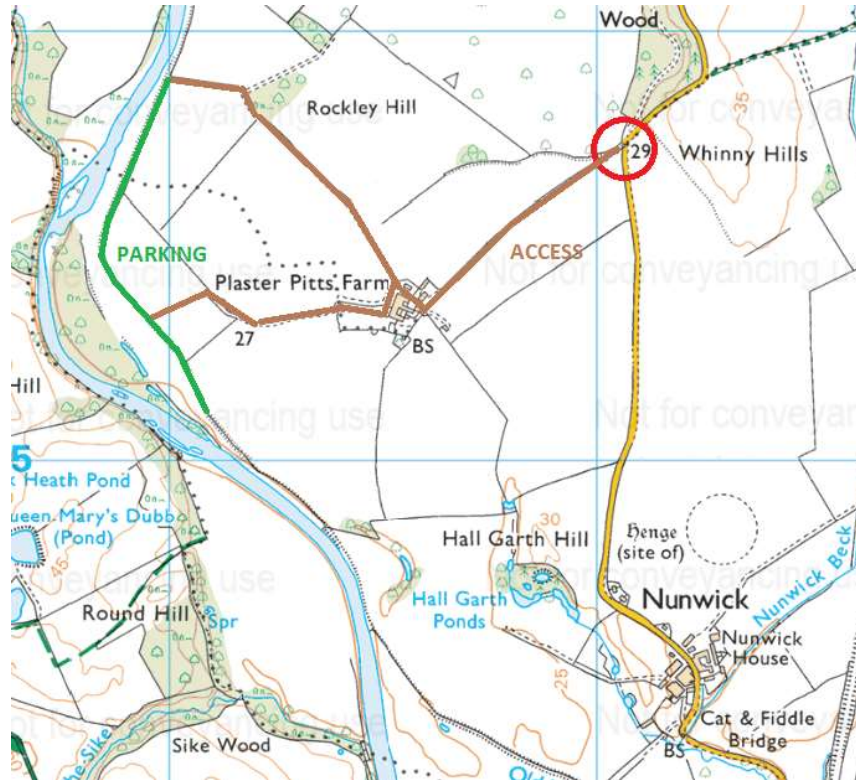

2nd Access – Plaster Pitts Farm (4X4 vehicle recommended in wet conditions)



Continue from Nunwick towards Wath for 0.9 miles. Turn Left down Plaster Pitts Farm track. At the end of the track take the right fork and turn right between the barn and the farm buildings through the gateway with the hedge on your right hand side. Follow the track to the River through the gate over the flood banking.

3rd Access – Gravel Works



Continue past the Plaster Pitts Farm entrance towards Wath. After approximately 0.8 miles turn left as you enter Wath, signposted Tanfield and Masham.

Continue for another 0.5 miles and turn left opposite a white house and follow the track for 0.9 miles.



Park on the left of the gravel works gates and walk to the river. Please keep out of the gravel works, access is along the river bank.
